Access fees reflect the principle of equity, based on the number of total students enrolled at elementary and secondary schools within the school board.

Group 1	- up to 15,000 students	\$ 7,875
Group 2	- 15,000 to 50,000 students	\$15,750
Group 3	- 50,000 to 100,000 students	\$23,625
Group 4	- over 100,000 students	\$31,500

- Boards in Group 2, 3 and 4 that connect through an ORION-eligible Regional Advanced Network (RAN) in their region may receive a discount. Fees are subject to PST and GST.
